

**Citizens for Strong Schools  
Minutes June 5, 2019**

Members of the Executive Committee for Citizens for Strong Schools held a “going forward” meeting at Bageland on June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 8:30 am. It was noted that the 1/2 cent sales tax initiative while very successful had been challenging for our volunteers, and we have several executive committee members who would no longer be serving on the Citizens for Strong Schools Board. There was consensus that the organization needed to regroup and recruit new volunteers for the upcoming 1 MIL referendum in November 2020.

By consensus it was determined that Mary Benedict would serve as new chair of Citizens for Strong Schools, the vice chair would need to be filled, and Tom Hollinger would serve as treasurer beginning October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 with Khan-Lien Banko continuing to serve as interim treasurer until that date. The annual report for the Florida Department of Corporations has been filed so an addendum will be refiled when Dr. Hollinger becomes treasurer.


Everyone was asked to bring “new names” of those who would be willing to serve on the Citizens for Strong Schools. We will activate our meetings in the fall of 2019.
