REVENUE

The following table shows the revenue of the State of New York for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1952, and for the corresponding period of the fiscal year ended June 30, 1951.

The total revenue for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1952, was \$1,285,462,000, an increase of \$108,462,000, or 8.5 percent, over the total revenue for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1951, which was \$1,177,000,000.

The increase in revenue was due to an increase in the revenue from the State Tax, which was \$98,462,000, or 10.5 percent, over the revenue for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1951, and to an increase in the revenue from the State Lottery, which was \$10,000,000, or 100 percent, over the revenue for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1951.

The revenue from the State Tax for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1952, was \$98,462,000, an increase of \$10,000,000, or 10.5 percent, over the revenue for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1951, which was \$88,462,000.
