



Outstanding Fines, F.S. 99.021

Pursuant to F.S. 99.021, each candidate, shall, at the time of subscribing to the oath or affirmation, state in writing whether he or she owes any outstanding fines, fees, or penalties that *cumulatively exceed \$250* for any violations of s. 8, Art. II of the State Constitution, the Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees under part III of chapter 112, any local ethics ordinance governing standards of conduct and disclosure requirements, or chapter 106.

Note: Any such fines that have been paid in full at the time of subscribing to the oath are not deemed to be outstanding.
