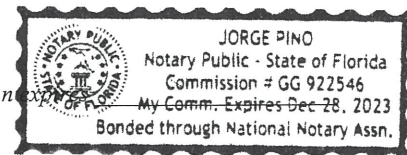

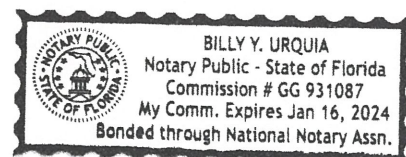

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My name is Alex Haq and I am running for Coral Gables City Commission Group II. I am a Coral Gables native and have resided in the City my whole life including attending school locally at St.

Theresa School and the University of Miami where I received a Bachelor of Arts in History/Theater Arts. I am proud to be a resident of the “City Beautiful” and as a student of history can appreciate the stories of its planning and development. I enjoy walking through my neighborhood and the downtown/Miracle Mile area, it is in doing so that I realize that our community is more than the beautiful Mediterranean buildings and lush greenspaces but the people as well.

I am running for City Commission in the hopes of merging the vision of George Merrick together with the growth and innovation of the 21st century. It is important to look to the future while remembering the lessons of the past which will enable us to maintain our identity. My desire to become involved in our local community stems from wanting to participate and make a difference. I believe we all can make a difference in the actions we take.

My platform will focus on several points:

1. We have all felt the pain of parking in Coral Gables and it has failed to keep step with the immense development that has taken place. Lack of parking has strained the small businesses in the area that are unable to contract with valet services. The effects of the pandemic have further devastated our local entrepreneurs. If we want to continue to provide a variety of shops and eating establishments that will set Coral Gables apart and attract customers, we need to provide convenient and plentiful parking near those establishments.
2. Development within the Coral Gables city limits has long been a source of debate. Existing structures being torn down to make way for tall buildings, homes replaced with McMansions that push to the property limits and leave no greenspace. There is a disconnect between what monied individuals can achieve versus an average homeowner trying to obtain a permit to change his front door. Part of what makes Coral Gables such a unique city was George

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Merrick's planning. I am certain that he would not have compromised the quality of life he

sought for the residents of his community in the sole name of profit. We must keep up with

the demands of modern living and working but if we allow development to run amok, we risk

losing the quality of life Coral Gables has afforded its residents for decades.

3. Who are we as a city? Are we an exclusive enclave of the wealthy? As a life-long resident of Coral Gables I realize that this city has always enjoyed high property values but over the years I have seen areas that were once affordable for young professionals torn down and replaced with lovely residences that can only be afforded by persons with means. When my parents got married 28 years ago they first rented an apartment near the Coral Gables library, after a few years they saved enough to purchase a small Old Spanish home in North Gables and after 5 years living there they moved to a larger home almost back where they began. They were both young professionals who wanted to live in Coral Gables and saved to make that dream a reality. It is a much more difficult dream to achieve these days. I believe our city should be affordable to all persons.

These are the main points of my platform but I continue listening and learning. My desire to make a difference and become involved in my community outweighs my lack of experience. With no economic ties to special interests, my allegiance is to the constituents which make up and deserve a City Beautiful.

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VOLUNTARY STATEMENT OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

As a candidate for public office in Miami-Dade County, I believe that political issues can be freely debated without appealing to racial, ethnic, religious, sexual, or other prejudices. I recognize that such negative appeals serve only to divide this community and create long-term moral, social, and economic problems. Therefore,

1. I shall not make my race, religion, national origin, gender, physical disability, or sexual orientation an issue in my campaign.
2. I shall not make my opponent's race, religion, national origin, gender, physical disability, or sexual orientation an issue in my campaign.
3. I will condemn any appeal to prejudice based on race, creed, national origin, religion, gender, physical disability, or sexual orientation.
4. I shall not, without just cause, attack or question my opponent's patriotism.
5. I shall not publish, display, or circulate any anonymous campaign literature or political advertisement.
6. I shall not tolerate my supporters engaging in these activities that I condemn, nor shall I accept their continued support if they engage in such activities. I will not permit any member of my campaign organization to engage in these activities and will immediately and publicly repudiate the support of any other individual or group that resorts to the methods and tactics I condemn.
7. I shall run a positive campaign emphasizing my qualifications for office and positions on issues of public concern.
8. I will limit my attacks on an opponent to legitimate challenges to that person's record, qualifications, and positions.
9. I will neither use nor permit the use of malicious untruths or innuendoes about an opponent's personal life, nor will I make or condone unfounded accusations discrediting that person's credibility.
10. I will take personal responsibility for approving or disavowing the substance of attacks on my opponent that may come from third parties supporting my candidacy.
11. I will not use or permit the use of campaign material that falsifies, distorts, or misrepresents facts.

BY SIGNING THIS DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER, I AGREE TO

- ABIDE BY THE VOLUNTARY STATEMENT OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES,

I also recognize that in signing this agreement, I will be forfeiting rights to which I would otherwise be entitled under the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and Article I, Section 4, of the Constitution of the State of Florida. DECLARATION FOR CANDIDATES NOT AUTOMATICALLY COVERED
by the Mandatory Provisions of the
Miami-Dade Ethical Campaign Practices Ordinance
Miami-Dade County Code at 2-11.1.1(C)

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The Mandatory Fair Campaign Practices Ordinance at Sec. 2-11.1.1(C) of the Miami-Dade County Code extends to—

- Candidates, and their respective campaign staffs, for Miami-Dade Co. Commissioners or Mayor;
- Candidates, and their respective campaign staffs, for Miami-Dade Co. Community Councils;
- Candidates, and their respective campaign staffs, for any municipal elective office within Miami-Dade County;
- Candidates, and their respective campaign staffs, for the Co. Property Appraiser.

Other candidates for elective office with a constituency in whole or in part in Miami-Dade Co. who are *not* required to comply with the Mandatory Fair Campaign Practices Ordinance *may* at any time declare that they agree to abide by the Mandatory Fair Campaign Practices Ordinance.

The Mandatory Fair Campaign Practices Ordinance states that a candidate shall not—

- (a) With actual malice make or cause to be made any untrue oral statement about another candidate or a member of his or her family or staff that exposes the person to hatred, contempt, or ridicule or causes the person to be shunned or avoided or injured in his or her business or occupation;
- (b) With actual malice publish, or cause to be published, by writing, printing, picture, effigy, sign, or otherwise than by mere speech any untrue statement about another candidate or a member of his or her family or staff that exposes the person to hatred, contempt, or ridicule or causes the person to be shunned or avoided or injured in his or her business or occupation;
- (c) Willfully injure, deface, or damage or cause to be injured, defaced, or damaged, by any means, any campaign poster, sign, leaflet, handbill, literature, or other campaign material of another candidate;
- (d) Knowingly obtain, or cause to be obtained, the campaign property of another candidate with the intent to temporarily or permanently deprive the candidate of a right to the property or its benefit; *or*
- (e) Knowingly file with the Ethics Commission a groundless or frivolous complaint against another candidate.
