BECOMING A CANDIDATE

You may announce your intention to become a candidate prior to appointing a treasurer or designating a depository; however, **FORM DS-DE 9: Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository must be filed with the Supervisor of Elections (filing officer county level candidates) Prior to the following.**

- **Opening a campaign account**
- **Accepting any contributions or making any expenditures or authorizing another to do so on your behalf**
- **Obtaining petition signatures on form DS-DE 104, Candidate Petition.**

Please keep in mind that form DS-DE 84 Statement of Candidate must be filed within 10 days of filing DS-DE 9. If filing for a judicial office form DS-DE 83 is required in addition to form DS-DE 84.

CAMPAIGN FINANCE "HIGHLIGHTS"

106.0705 Electronic filing of campaign treasurer's reports

Chapter 106, Florida Statutes requires campaigns of all candidates, political committees and electioneering communications committees to file regular reports of all campaign contributions and expenditures (**see 2025- 2026 Calendar of Reporting Dates in Candidate Packet**).

- Campaign finance reports filed through the electronic filing system are considered to be under oath by the candidate and treasurer are certified to be correct and true s.106.07, the chair and treasurer, the treasurer under s. 106.0703, or the leader and treasurer under s. 103.092, whichever is applicable, and such persons are subject to the provisions of s. 106.07(5), s. 106.0703(4), or s. 106.29(2), as applicable.
- Reports must be filed through the electronic filing system no later than midnight on the designated due date. Campaign finance reports not filed by midnight are deemed late filed and are subject to the penalties pursuant to F.S.106.07(8).

Penalty for Late Filing: Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports **immediately preceding the primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day**, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For a candidate's termination report (F.S. 106.141 (8)), the fine shall be \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater for the period covered by the late report. **All fines must be paid from the candidate's personal funds – not campaign funds. (Sections 106.07(2) and (8), Fla. Stat.)**

Incomplete Reports: If a candidate or campaign treasurer files a report that is deemed incomplete, they will be notified by the filing officer as to why the report is incomplete. The candidate or campaign treasurer must file an amendment to the incomplete report within seven days of notification. The amendment must include all necessary information to complete the report. Failure to file a complete report after notice constitutes a violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.106.07(2)(b).

No Activity: In any reporting period "No Activity" occurred; did not receive funds or make any expenditures the Supervisor of Elections must be notified in writing on or before the prescribed reporting date. The notice must be filed through the electronic filing system. See Electronic Filing Instructions on how to "Create Waiver of Report".

Changing Parties for Partisan Offices

Candidate with Party Affiliation

Any person seeking to qualify for nomination as a candidate of any political party shall, at the time of subscribing to the oath or affirmation, state in writing: 1. The party of which the person is a member. 2. That the person has been a registered member of the political party for which they are seeking nomination as a candidate for 365 days before the beginning of qualifying preceding the general election for which the person seeks to qualify. 3. That the person has paid the assessment levied against him or her, if any, as a candidate for said office by the executive committee of the party of which he or she is a member. (Note: This provision also applies to individuals seeking election to a political party executive committee office.) (Section 99.021(1)(b) and (2), Fla. Stat.)

Candidate with No Party Affiliation

Any person seeking to qualify for office as a candidate with no party affiliation shall, at the time of subscribing to the oath or affirmation, state in writing that he or she is registered without any party affiliation and that he or she has not been a registered member of any political party for 365 days before the beginning of qualifying preceding the general election for which the person seeks to qualify. (Section 99.021(1), Fla. Stat.)

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Statement of Ethical Campaign Practices

As a candidate for public office in Seminole County, I believe political issues can be freely debated without appealing to prejudices. Positive campaigning promotes citizen involvement.
Therefore:

1. I will run a campaign emphasizing my qualifications for office and my positions on issues of public concerns and I will limit my criticism of an opponent to legitimate challenges to that person's record, qualifications, and positions.
2. I will condemn any appeal to prejudice based on race, religion, gender, age, national origin, marital status, or physical disability.
3. I will not publish, display, or circulate any anonymous campaign literature, political advertisements, emails, websites, blogs, social media entries, etc., nor will I permit members of my campaign organization to engage in such activities.
4. I will provide campaign finance reports which accurately reflect the contributions received and expenditures made.
5. I will not permit members of my campaign organization to engage in activities designed to destroy or remove campaign signs lawfully displayed on public or private property.
6. I will not permit the use of untruths or innuendoes about an opponent's personal life.
7. I will at all times tell the truth, with complete documentation from legitimate, verifiable sources for any charges against my opponent(s), and substantiate claims about my own record.
8. I will not use or permit use of campaign material that falsifies, distorts, or misrepresents facts.
9. I recognize that duty to my country, my state, my county and my own ethics outweigh any personal ambition for public office.
10. I will not permit any member of my campaign to engage in these activities and will immediately and publicly repudiate the support of any other individual or group which resorts to the methods and tactics that I hereby condemn.

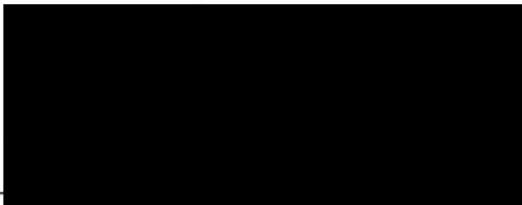

Willful failure to file this form is a first degree misdemeanor and a civil violation of the Campaign Financing Act which may result in a fine of up to \$1,000, (ss. 106.19(1)(c), 106.265(1), Florida Statutes).

Pursuant to Florida law, and at the request of the Supervisor of Elections, the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County has adopted Resolution 2011-R-152 (8/23/2011) regarding electronic filing requirements of campaign finance reports for local candidates, political committees and county executive committees of a political party. All of these entities are required to file electronically with Seminole County Supervisor of Elections Office via an Internet-based electronic filing system.

1. Sign-in Credentials

Each person will be issued Sign-in Credentials, a log-in name and password, by the Seminole County Supervisor of Elections Office to access ("sign-in") the Electronic Filing System. You are responsible for safeguarding this sign-in information and for notifying the Supervisor of Elections Office should this information be lost or become compromised.

Please note: Only one log-in name and password will be issued for both the candidate and treasurer (or committee chair and treasurer, as applicable)

2. PIN

The sign-in credentials will serve as a PIN (personal identification number). This PIN is considered the same as your signature on a paper filed report.

3. Reports

Reports shall be completed and filed electronically through the Seminole County Supervisor of Elections **electronic filing system not later than Midnight (Eastern Standard Time) of the day designated**. When your report is electronically filed, the Status column in your report list will indicate "Submitted" along with a confirmation number. The PDF version of the report may be printed and retained for your records as your "Electronic Filing Receipt" which reflects the confirmation number, date and time of submission. Any reports that I file through the electronic filing system are considered to be certified as to correctness within the meaning of Sections 106.07(5) or 106.29(2), F.S.

4. Reports Not Timely Filed

If a required report is not filed timely the relevant penalty sections in Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, shall apply. All reports filed via this system are considered to be under oath by the candidate and treasurer, chair and treasurer of political committees and county executive of a political party and are subject to all relevant penalties in Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
