Dear Ms. Woolsey:

The campaign treasurer's report that was due on August 19, 2022, was not filed until August 20, 2022. Accordingly, you are fined in the amount of \$500.00 (for the reports immediately preceding each special primary election, special election, primary election, and general election, the fine is \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report per section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes). Such fine is not an allowable campaign expenditure and shall be paid only from personal funds of the candidate. The fine must be paid to the Supervisor of Elections within 20 days of receipt of this notice unless appealed to the Florida Elections Commission.

If you wish to appeal the fine, you must submit a notice of appeal to the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days of the date of the receipt of this notice. (See Rules 2B-1.005, 2B-1.0052 and 2B-1.0055, Florida Administrative Code.) The Florida Elections Commission address is 107 West Gaines Street, Suite 224, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0100.
